

## Conditions of Entry

- This event is run under Pony Club Rules. It is the competitors' responsibility to check that their tack conforms.
- Competitors must be paid up members of the Pony Club.
- All Pony Club entries from visiting branches **must be signed** by their District Commissioner or Secretary.
- Age for Class 2 as of 1st January 2008.
- No horse or pony accepted if under the age of 5 years.
- No horse or pony can be ridden by more than one competitor, and no horse may be entered more than once. Riders may enter more than one horse per class.
- No entries accepted without the appropriate fee.
- Please let the Entries Secretary know as soon as possible if you are unable to compete. No money will be refunded after the close of entries, but replacement entries may be accepted.
- In the case of abandonment, entries will be refunded less a handling fee.
- Insurance is as detailed in the Pony Club Year book 2008.
- The organisers decision is final. They reserve the right to refuse entry, to cancel or alter any class at their discretion. Any objection is to be made in writing with a £10 deposit within 30 minutes of the occurrence.
- Persons not attending the prize giving will forfeit their prize.
- Dogs must be on leads at all times.
- Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars or their contents and accessories, or any person or property whatsoever, whether cause by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
- By completing the entry form, it is deemed that you accept and agree to abide by the above rules.

## Health & Safety

A riding hat must be worn, correctly fastened, when mounted. The hat must conform with the Pony Club hat rule (Rule 11) and be tagged with a Pony Club hat tag. An effective body protector must be worn for the Cross Country phase.

The Organisers of this Event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
